




State of the Laboratory

 LANL Facilities are Old & Need Significant Upgrades

8.9 M square feet

- $\frac{1}{2} > 30$ years old
- ½ are in fair, poor, or failing condition
- Over the next 10 years
 - 7 M ft² will be > 30 years
 old

Los Alamos Science Complex




- Alternative Financing for non-directly funded, critically needed facilities

US Postal Service Authority to Develop





US Code Title 39, Part 1, Chapter 4, Section 411

... Executive agencies within the meaning of section 105 of title 5 and the Government Printing Office are authorized to furnish property, both real and personal, and personal and nonpersonal services to the Postal Service, and the Postal Service is authorized to furnish property and services to them . . .

NNSA's Los Alamos Site Office executed a Memorandum of Understanding with the US Postal Service on February 9, 2004.
