

Moving Los Alamos National Laboratory Beyond the Cold War

On Monday, July 2, Department of Energy and LANL officials and some expected Congressional Members are "celebrating" the first production in 18 years of a plutonium pit "trigger" for the already excessive nuclear stockpile. In contrast, there is growing Congressional and public sentiment that Lab missions should be changed to tackle contemporary national security threats and the energy challenges facing the U.S. and the world. Advocates for these changes will discuss their proposals, while a highly experienced retired nuclear weapons designer will comment on the present reliable status of the U.S. stockpile.
