

National Nuclear Security Administration Los Alamos National Laboratory Site-Wide Environmental Impact Statement Public Scoping Meetings



The Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) is holding two online public scoping meetings to invite public participation in the process and to encourage public input on the scope and alternatives that should be considered in the Los Alamos National Laboratory Draft Site-Wide Environmental Impact Statement (SWEIS). The LANL SWEIS will analyze the potential environmental impacts of the reasonable alternatives for continuing LANL operations for approximately the next 15 years. In light of current public health concerns NNSA will be hosting two internet-based (with telephone access), virtual scoping meetings in place of in-person meetings.
